1. Introduction

Merge Articles is a great tool to help merge multiple articles in .txt format together to create one large article for use in text rotators and other tools. Follow these simple instructions to begin.

2. Installation Steps

2.1 Running the installer

Double click the Merge Articles icon to open the program.

3. Usage

3.1 Below is what the interface looks like



You will need to select the Input Folder which contains all the .txt articles.

Then select the Target Folder. This can be the same as the Input Folder or a different folder altogether.

All text files will be merged into a single Mater Filename called Master.txt. You can also rename this anything that you like.


The Article Separator is the token code that is used to recognize where one article ends and the next begin. %BREAK% is the default token code. You can also rename so it works with any software or script you are currently using.

4. Other Options

4.1 Open Master file after processing

If you want to view your master text file after your articles are merged, simply check the box 'Open Master file after processing'.
